Additionally, all OpenPKG packages follow *exactly* the same style as this example (i.e., everything is fixed — the order of headers, the indentations, etc.). This allows developers to easily query and even semi-automatically edit package information directly from the source. For example, the indices on the FTP server are auto-generated this way, and the release engineering procedures can be mostly automated.
